IT'S PICNIC TIME!

It's always good to see supportive investors and curious visitors at camp. So we're hoping you'll join us at the "feast" this year to hear our latest news & plans, to ask questions and VOTE for your Board of Directors.

Whether you can be an active investor now or not, any current developments always "stand on the shoulders" of earlier investors. So, be sure, you're welcome to enjoy good friends, food and news at our annual picnic on SUNDAY, JUNE 4th!

One way old and new investors actually "work together" was demonstrated after investors enabled purchasing a great camera for inspecting earlier diamond-drill probe holes. This camera is a DANDY! Recently, it "rescued" an old (pre-camera) project by proving an electronic target, in the last newsletter, was mis-labeled as: "High Resistance Rock / Mineral." From drilling alone, we believed we only found solid rock but, after the camera arrived, it clearly SHOWED there IS a void where a void was electronically mapped. Seeing is believing and the partial void we see is about 1 ft. wide & 10 feet long! Another thing of certainty is that the aragonite crystals seen in the void is proof airflow has existed there for a long time. More drilling and camera work will

show if there are more cavern surprises on either side.

Another place we'll be RE viewing with this new camera is "Steve Clemens' 2nd Chimney." It's DEEP inside Kokoweef Peak, it's 140 ft below the track level of the old Crystal Cave network AND it "breathes" a high volume of air through a 10 inch wide fracture. This is good evidence for large caverns below but, since the opening twists out of view using unaided eyesight, who knows? The camera's 600 foot, flexible "snake cable" will allow us to look farther to SEE if it widens into a large cavern. Fortunately, no extensive excavating is required at Steve's 2nd Chimney.

The next project to be REviewed is a 6" hole drilled 12 years ago, in the *middle of the base camp*, to a depth of 237 feet. At that depth, *all the drilling air disappeared* into a crack linked with some large volume. Air at 2,400 cubic feet per minute, under 250 pounds of pressure, was being pumped down with no back pressure for over five minutes. But, then the drill *got stuck*, it *got expensive* and the driller *got outta* there! Finally, we'll get to SEE what's at the bottom of that old hole with our new camera!

Whether you're an old or new investor, friendship and goodwill still remain "the best investments with the best returns." This was the case as

it relates to Willard Dorr, Jr. He was a nephew of Earl Dorr. (His Uncle Earl wrote the 1934 affadavit describing the legendary "River-of-Gold.") During a visit with Willard Dorr, shortly after last year's picnic, Willard was shown the photos & a map of the marker-rocks found on Kokoweef. Even months later, in spite of an illness, Willard kept his engineer's curiosity about those set-stones. Sadly, he passed away last January. But, before entering the hospital, he insisted your editor accept his new surveyor's transit as a gift. He believed it would be helpful to "... finish the work you started with those marker rocks!" And Willard was right because his kindness soon be-

came a catalyst for discoveries. Previously, it was believed the concentration of set-stone markers were only related to some LOCAL potential at the Brushy Area (Site G-68). But, by sighting in with the 20X telescope on his surveyor's transit, it was discovered our "marker-map" involves a much larger area. (See photo above) Those "local," short-line markers were originally set with extreme precision because they lined up exactly with more set-stone markers over 2,000 feet away! All their mysteries haven't been been solved but the markers seem to be related to the MAJOR Infra-Red Fault running under the base camp.

Larry Hahn has found just the right combinations for us in a LARGE drill operated by *REDDING DRILLING* in Las Vegas. They have a brand new rig that can drill a 6" hole 2,000 ft deep! At a special rate of \$10 per foot, this deal is excellent for a rig having this capability! It's IMPRESSIVE to see them drill down 100 feet every hour! At the right spot 20 hours = 1 canyon.



DRIVING TO KOKOWEEF?

From Vegas: Take 1-15 South, past Primm Valley Casinos and go up past the Nipton Rd. sign and exit at BAILEY ROAD. Go left across the bridge AND cattle grating, then left on 1/2 mile of pavement, continue on dirt road and follow signs for 4 miles up, up, up to the flat land ... Kokoweef Peak is seen to your left. From Baker, CA: 1-15 North, up past Halloran Spring & Halloran Summit, down past rest area and Cima Rd, up & exit BAILEY ROAD. Go right, follow signs
